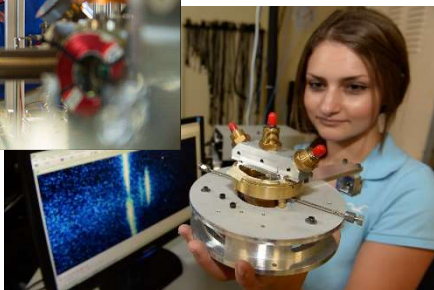
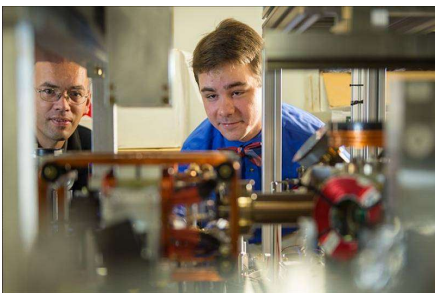
Waves in Physics
