Benefits

During this two-year program, you will receive:

- Up to \$36,000/year in tuition assistance
- \$32,000/year stipend, including housing allowance
- \$5,000/year for required educational expenses such as conferences and workshops
- Two paid 10-week summer internships (weekly stipends with housing, transportation, and travel allowances)

Eligibility

- US Citizen age 18 or older
- 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Be enrolled as an undergraduate student at an MSI pursuing a STEM degree
- Graduating Spring 2026 or later
